SUBJECT: IDLE SERVICES

POLICY:

The Cooperative shall periodically make a field survey to determine the idle facilities (Primary, transformers and secondary services), and keep a list of the locations. The following shall be considered when validating idle services.

Valid reasons for leaving some facilities in place are:

1. Possible future use.
2. The cost of removal compared with salvage values.
3. Territorial protection.
4. Shortage of help to remove the facilities.

Valid reasons for retirement of idle facilities are:

1. Reduction of operating expenses and depreciation.
2. The removal of potential hazards to the public.
3. The probable effect on the aesthetics factor.
4. Reuse of material to help offset costs of the Cooperative.
5. Vacant account status for twelve (12) months.
