Board Policy No. 328

SUBJECT: OUTDOOR LIGHTING

POLICY:

This classification includes street and park lighting systems, traffic signal systems, outdoor lighting, security lighting, and athletic field lighting installations. Service under these classifications will be provided under the appropriate provisions and the applicable rate schedule and in accordance with the provisions stated thereunder as Rules and Regulations of the TVA Contract.

The Cooperative may require a contract of original term of up to five years and may require an advance payment. Service of a new installation or of existing light(s) will require a contract after this policy is effective.

The policy of the Cooperative regarding the providing of Outdoor Lighting is as follows:

1. The Cooperative will furnish, install on an existing pole, maintain, and provide electric energy to a photo-electrically controlled type light(s) for a flat facility rate (charge) plus energy rate (charge) monthly. These rates are subject to change.
2. Should the member desire the light(s) installed on a non-existing pole to locate the light(s) at a preferred location, there will be an additional charge per pole. This additional charge shall be paid in aid of construction before installation of lighting facilities.
3. The member further agrees that the unit, together with the pole(s) and line(s) may be removed at any time by the Cooperative upon failure to pay the charges set forth herein, or, when deemed necessary by the Cooperative. Discontinuance or removal due to non-payment of the monthly charges does not relieve the member from the one (1) year minimum obligation as set forth below.
4. The member agrees to notify the Cooperative when the light(s) fails to operate properly and the Cooperative shall make every reasonable effort to service the unit as soon as is reasonable considering the current workload and public welfare. Further, the member agrees to protect the unit from damage in so far as possible.
5. The facilities installed to provide the light(s) service shall remain the property of the Cooperative.
6. The approval of this application (see attached) by the Cooperative shall constitute a contractual agreement between the member and the Cooperative, and the contract for light service shall continue in force and effect for at least one year from the date service is rendered by the Cooperative to the member and year to year thereafter until canceled by either party upon thirty days written notice.

7. The Member hereby grants to the Cooperative the necessary rights-of-way upon the member's premises for the installation of any pole(s), line(s), guy(s), etc., which may be required to provide the light(s) service; and to confer upon the Cooperative the right of ingress and egress upon said premises from time to time as required for the purposes of installation, maintenance, inspection, repair, or removal of said pole(s), line(s), and equipment.
8. If the member desires underground service connections, the Cooperative may in accordance with its terms require aid-of-construction and/or additional fees to provide service.
9. The contract for Outdoor Lighting shall be effective upon execution by both parties hereto and shall insure to the benefit of and be binding upon the respective heirs, legal representatives, successors, and assigns of the parties hereto.
10. When so authorized by policy duly adopted by the Cooperative's Board of Directors, special outdoor lighting installations (other than as provided in above policies and TVA agreements) may be provided, owned, and maintained by the Cooperative. Reimbursement may be required from the member in aid of construction or monthly charges sufficient to cover the costs.
11. The Cooperative reserves the right to reject provision of lighting, if it is determined by management that the member(s) should be responsible for their lighting needs.
