POLICY NO. 305**

SUBJECT: **CODING CLASSIFICATION**

OBJECTIVES:

- A. To provide general guidance to Cooperative employees in the coding of most utilized retail electric rates of the Cooperative.

- B. To assure compliance with the standards specified in the most recent Rate Agreement between TVA and the Cooperative.

POLICY:

Employees must abide by the standing agreement between TVA and the Cooperative in regard to rates.

A "code" exists for each type of distribution account. This policy will help to clarify the most commonly utilized rate codes (classifications). **Codes (classifications) exist beyond those commonly utilized and employees should continue to consult with TVA and FLEC management in regard to other codes available under the current Rate Agreement.**

CODE

SERVICE

Residential Service (Residential Rate)

- 22 This rate shall apply only to electric service to a single-family dwelling (including its appurtenances if served through the same meter), where the major use of electricity is for domestic purposes such as lighting, household appliances, and the personal comfort and convenience of those residing therein.

Commercial & Industrial Service (General Power Rate)

This rate shall apply to the firm power requirements (where a customer's contract demand is 5,000 kW or less) for electric service to commercial, industrial, and governmental customers (members), and to institutional customers including, without limitation, churches, clubs, fraternities, orphanages, nursing homes, rooming or boarding houses, and like customers. This rate shall also apply to customers (members) to whom service is not available under any other resale rate schedule.

Commercial & Industrial Service (General Power Rate)... continued:

- 40 GSA-1** (Demand under 50 kW and less than 15,000 kWh usage): Customer (member) billed for a demand normally under 50 kW and less than 15,000 kWh (monthly usage).
- 50 GSA-2** (Demand greater than 50 kW and less than 1,000 kW (or less than 50 kW, but more than 15,000 kWh usage)): Customer (member) billed for demand normally over 50 kW and less than 1,000 kW or when usage exceeds 15,000 kWh (monthly usage).
- 54 GSA-3** (Demand greater than 1,000 kW (monthly usage)): Customer (member) billed for demand normally over 1,000 kW.

Outdoor Lighting Service (Outdoor Lighting Rate)

77 LS This rate is available for service to street and park lighting systems, traffic signal systems, athletic field lighting installations, and outdoor lighting for individual customers (members). Service under this schedule is for a term of not less than 1 year.
